Minimum 58% as Ortho-Ortho isomer for the prevention and correction of Iron chlorosis and deficiency in crops and soils.



Iron Chelate is recommended for use as a soil application where iron levels are low or deficient, according to soil samples. Iron Chelate can be applied on all soil types but is most effective on soils with pH >7.5.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Use only as directed.

**SOIL APPLICATION:**

- dissolve 2 - 10 g per 1l water, and apply by watering in the area of the feeding roots. Avoid wetting the plant leaves as this may cause damage to the plant.
  - Alternatively, sprinkle as a dry powder and water in afterwards
  - Application should be at the rates recommended.
  - Incorporate into the top few centimetres of soil as soon as possible after application. After that, water the plants.
  - Apply before sowing or planting.
- (\*Actual quantities required will depend on plant size and degree of deficiency.)

**CROP DOSAGE RATES:**

Vegetable Crops:	(5 - 10 g / m <sup>2</sup> ). See Soil Application.
Fruit and Citrus:	25g+ / tree. Read insert. See Soil Application.
Grapevines:	7.5 - 15 g / vine. See Soil Application.
Ornamentals (Azaleas, Rhododendrons, Roses):	5 - 50 g / plant. See Soil Application.
